Washtenaw Community College Computed Tomography (CPCTOM)

The Computed Tomography program will not run in the Fall 2025 semester due to the upcoming retirement of our current program instructor. WCC is in the process of hiring a new faculty member, and until that position is filled, we are unable to provide a definitive timeline for when the program will be offered again.

If the program is offered in the <u>Fall 2026</u> semester, the application is expected to become available in <u>mid-April 2026</u>.

Students are admitted to the program on a <u>first-qualified basis</u> until all seats are filled or until the application deadline (whichever comes first). The final application deadline for the Fall 2026 semester (if offered) is anticipated to be in <u>late July or early August</u> <u>2026</u>. To be eligible to apply for the next available admission cycle, all admission requirements must be successfully completed by the application deadline.
